# GUEST LECTURE ON MALE & FEMALE RELATIONSHIP AND TEACHER'S ROLE

Dr. Ganeshchandra Shinde, Principal of Yeshwant Mahavidyalaya, Nanded, Internal Complaints Committee, Mahila Suraksha & Sudhar Samiti and Gender Sensitivity Cell of College organized a Guest Lecture on Male & Female Relationship And Teacher's Role on the Occasion of 'Diamond Jubilee Celebration' of Yeshwant Mahavidyalaya; and directives given by University Grant Commission, Delhi to celebrate Women's week through Women's Awareness Programme (25-11-2022 to 10-12-2022) on 09-12-2022.

After Warm welcoming of all the guests, Anchoring of the program was done by Dr. Kavita Sonkamble and she also given initial introduction of programme.

Dr. Atnoorkar Address:

Dr. Atnoorkar briefly highlighted the various aspects of relationships between men and women, as well as between male and female students. The highlights of his talk includes natural attraction and bonding between individuals, physical and mental changes during adolescence and youth, the role of mothers and teachers, and how mothers guide their daughters towards appropriate sexual guidance, what is right and what is wrong, and how to take care of oneself in society. Fathers

should also guide their sons in a similar manner. If children make mistakes in choosing the right path, then who should take responsibility for that, and parents and teachers should not neglect this issue.

He told Due to the responsibilities given to women by nature (menstrual cycles, giving birth, nurturing, and raising children), women should be respected. Answers to various sexual questions that arise in the minds of children should be provided, considering hormonal changes in their bodies, peer pressure, and family influence. He said Proper sexual education should be given to them at the right time through a separate course in college. He has explained How to maintain relationships while working together. He told Teachers should provide guidance on mentoring. Decisions regarding sexual education are important. In today's internet era, considering age and maturity is crucial when discussing such topics.

Dr. Atnoorkar told Sexual education is essential for adolescents to understand their body structure and to prevent potential risks in the future. Therefore, the dissemination and promotion of sexual education should be carried out at all educational levels. There should be no correlation between students' mistakes, the level of education, and the extent of sexual education. On the contrary, the level of education should be elevated to prevent students' mistakes. Students should be encouraged to take an interest in practicing to avoid mistakes. Today's younger generation has become very fast-paced due to mobile internet, and we should not forget this. Considering the mental state of young people and the questions they may have; we can make them aware through sexual education. Becoming older and receiving education happen at the same time. Therefore, it is crucial to understand their emotional state. Even though it may be difficult to prevent young people from accessing the internet, it is very important to have a dialogue with them to provide sexual education and to understand their mental state. This dialogue should be carried out by bringing together parents, teachers, doctors, and counsellors, as Dr. Aatnoorkar has clearly stated.

It is inherent in humans to have sexual tendencies, and sexual education should be given keeping this in mind. It is important to provide sexual education without any taboos or hesitation. Therefore, the importance of sexual education should be emphasized by all stakeholders, and a collaborative effort should be made to carry out this important task.

Shri. Narendra dada Chavan Address:

The Chief Guest Shri. Narendra dada Chavan told Too many young people receive confusing and conflicting information about puberty, relationships, love and sex, as they make the transition from childhood to adulthood. A growing number of studies show that young people are turning to the

digital environment as a key source of information about sexuality. He told Sexual education is need of a curriculum-based process of teaching and learning about the cognitive, emotional, physical and social aspects of sexuality. It aims to equip students and young people with knowledge, skills, attitudes and values that empowers them to realize their health, well-being and dignity; develop respectful social and sexual relationships; consider how their choices affect their own well-being and that of others; and understand and ensure the protection of their rights throughout their lives

Dr. Raosaheb Shendarkar Address:

I presidential address Dr. Ravsaheb Shendarkar told importance of sex education in today's scenario. Sex Education is the activity of offering knowledge about sex & sexuality. It helps to gain the information to make healthy decisions about sex & sexuality. It also includes teaching & learning about the new things related to sex. Sex Education also helps to manage our sexual health. He said Quality sexual health education is really needed to help students have the knowledge and skill that they need to make really important health decisions.
