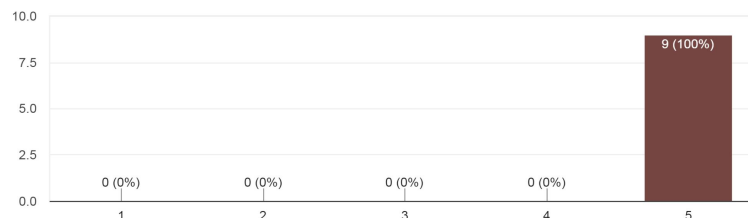


# Feedback by the Faculty 2022-23

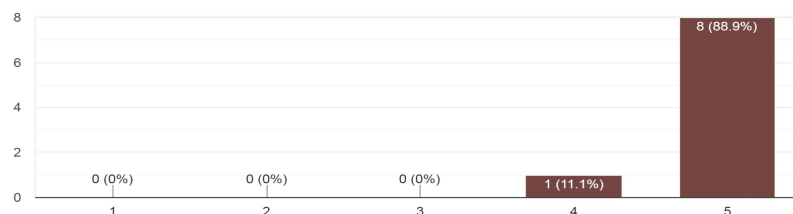

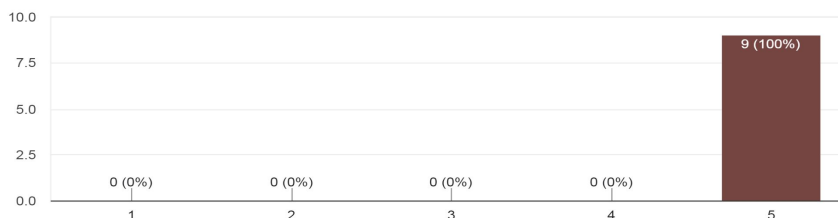

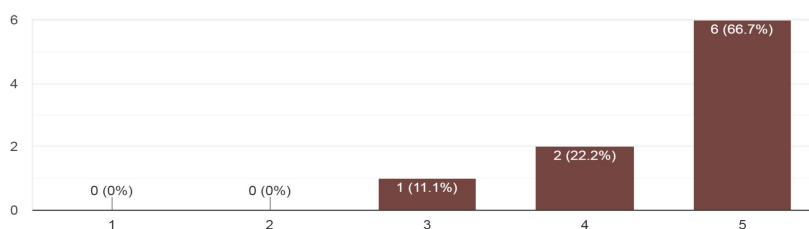

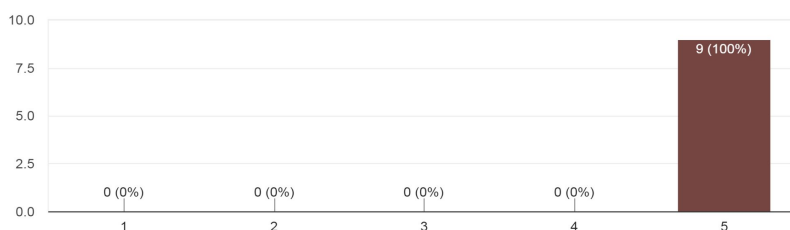

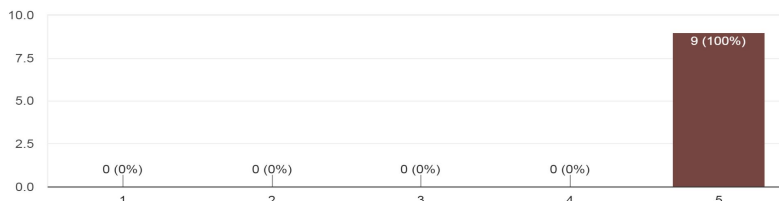

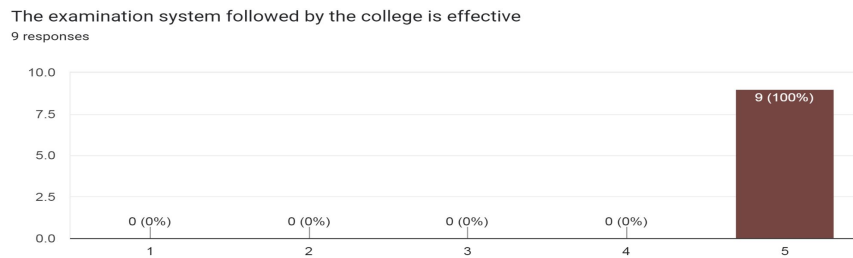
