Common instrumentation center (CIC) In-charge Prof. S. P. Vartale also offered warm welcome to MSC first year students and briefed the CIC lab. In his speech, Dr. S. Vartale gave talked about significance and applications of different instrument of CIC lab which includes Fourier-Transform Infrared Spectrophotometer (FT-IR), Spectrofluorophotometer (RF), UV-Spectrophotometer (UV), High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometry (GC-MS), Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer (AAS), Differential Thermogravimetric Analyser (DTG) etc. Also told about their principle and working, instrumentation and applications of instruments.

he also talked about the benefits CIC for Ph.D research scholar and PG student in their research and also for getting jobs into reputed pharmaceutical industries like LUPIN PHARMA, ALKMINE PHARMA, FLORINTICES PHARMA etc. as well as research institute like NCL Pune, IICT Hyderabad, IIT Mumbai, and IISc Bangalore etc. he also introduced all departmental activities conducted throughout the year like a workshop, Hands-on training, guest lecture etc. for PG IInd year student and mentioned can take benefits of this all to improve knowledge, research skill and to make carrier goals.
