The Department offered three programmes like Under graduation B.A. History, Post-Graduation M.A. History & Ph. D. The Undergraduate (B.A.) Programme in History, offered as an optional subject is a three-year programme structured in accordance with the framework of the National Education Policy 2020. With an approved intake of 420 students on a grant-in-aid basis and additional self-financed divisions of 100 seats each for Marathi and English medium, the programme allocates 50% of the total intake to History as an optional subject. As an academic discipline, History offers significant intellectual and practical utility by enabling learners to critically engage with past events, socio-cultural transformations, and contemporary global challenges. The curriculum, designed on **NEP-2020** principles, promotes multidisciplinary learning, flexibility, skill enhancement, and outcome-based education through a balanced integration of core, elective, and value-added courses. The programme outcomes include the development of critical thinking, analytical reasoning, research aptitude, and effective communication skills, thereby enhancing students' academic progression and employability in diverse fields such as education, research, public service, heritage management, and cultural industries. By fostering historical consciousness and ethical awareness, the programme underscores the importance of History as a vital optional subject within the B.A. framework.

The Postgraduate (M. A.) Programme in History, offered by the PG Department of History is a two-year degree programme designed in alignment with the principles and framework of the **National Education Policy 2020**. The programme has an intake capacity of 80

seats under the grant-in-aid category and 80 seats under self-financing, and is structured to provide advanced and specialized knowledge of historical processes, historiography, and interdisciplinary approaches. Integrating theoretical learning with practical components such as Art & Architecture, field visits, project work, and a research-based dissertation, the programme enhances critical thinking, analytical ability, research skills, and academic writing. Its utility lies in preparing students for higher research, competitive examinations, and diverse professional fields. The outcomes include the development of subject expertise, methodological competence, and intellectual independence, enabling learners to engage with contemporary issues through historical perspectives. The programme significantly enhances employability by opening career opportunities in teaching, research, archives, museums, heritage and tourism sectors, media, civil services, and cultural administration. With its strong academic foundation and research orientation, the M. A. History programme is an ideal choice for students aspiring for advanced scholarship, professional growth, and meaningful engagement with society.

The Ph.D. Programme in History, offered by the UG and PG Department of History & Research Centre at Yeshwant Mahavidyalaya, Nanded, affiliated with Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded is a research-intensive doctoral programme designed to cultivate advanced scholarship, critical inquiry, and original contribution to historical knowledge in accordance with the regulations of the University Grants Commission and the University. The intake for the programme is determined as per university allocation, and the duration is governed by prevailing UGC and institutional norms, with mandatory coursework forming a foundational component to strengthen research methodology & research ethics. The programme primarily encourages research in areas such as the Hyderabad Freedom Struggle and Modern Indian History, while also supporting diverse thematic explorations. Its academic utility lies in developing high-level analytical, interpretative, and writing skills, enabling scholars to engage with archival sources, fieldwork, and contemporary historiographical debates.
