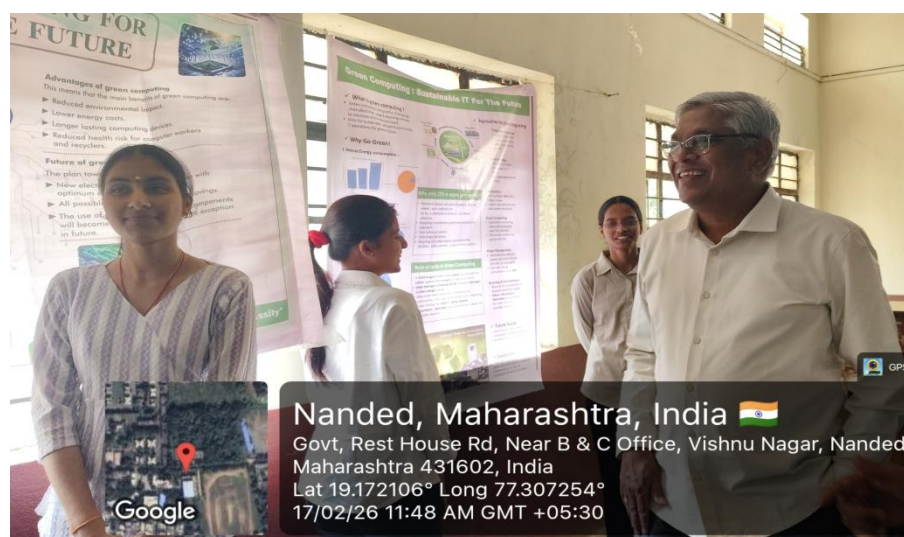

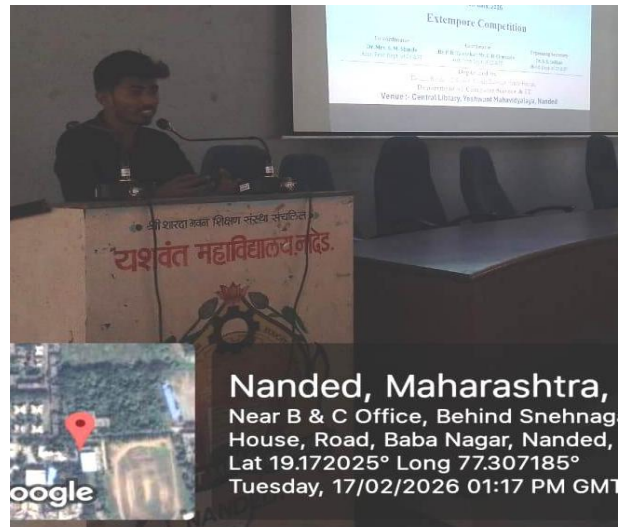


Poster Presentation: Examiner of event assessing the posters

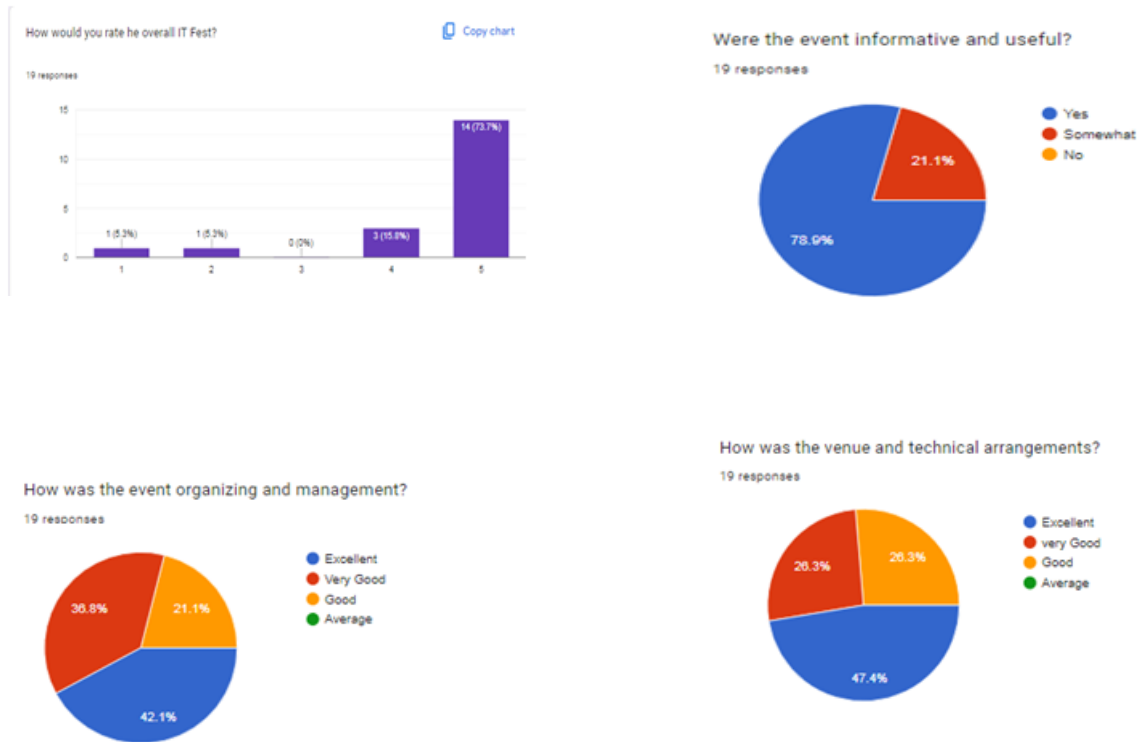

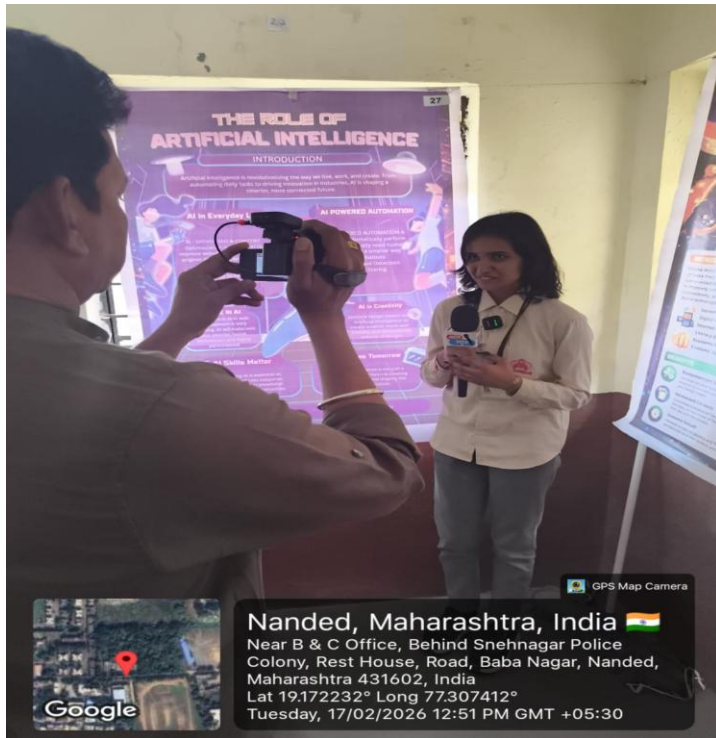
