In all 24 students from Science and 15 students from Humanities, Commerce & Management registered for Student presentation, whereas only 21 participated from Science and 12 from Humanities, Commerce & Management participated. Student presentation commenced by Professor M. V. Baig. He gave ideas about oral presentation for students. He further said that importance of celebrating this year as millet year. He also told everything about the view-points such as the PM urged the schools and the colleges to held the exhibitions and events to create awareness among people on Millet’s.

He further added that a science exhibition is an event hosted by various schools and colleges that deals with multiple project entries that employ different scientific methods.

The main reason behind organizing such science exhibitions or science fairs is to provide a platform to students where they can implement the various scientific theories/methods through various projects/models. In other words, a science exhibition is a platform where students can showcase how much they have understood the different scientific theories through their projects/models. It also helps to build the ability for teamwork and cooperation among students.

As explaining the importance of Millet by PM, he said that Millet is a good source of protein, fiber, key vitamins, and minerals. The potential health benefits of millet include protecting cardiovascular health, preventing the onset of diabetes, helping people achieve and maintain a healthy weight, and managing inflammation in the gut. Millet is an adaptable grain. There are many simple

ways to prepare it, making it easy for people with celiac disease to include this gluten-free grain in their diets.
