Yeshwant Mahavidyalaya, Nanded-431 602


For further details regarding selection of colleges under CPE kindly refer to UGC Website www.ugc.ac.in.

The colleges selected would be given the entire allocation during remaining period of X Plan, as specified in the Guidelines. An advance grant is also being released separately.

Some time during October '2004, the Principals of the colleges will be required to make a presentation about their Action Plan before an Expert Committee at UGC office, New Delhi. Further details will be sent to the college(s) in due course.

Finally, I would like to inform you that wherever the slots fixed for a State/Union Territory has not been filled up during the first round, fresh proposals will be invited in due course to fill up the vacant slots.



THE GRANT IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITION

- 1. The sanctioned amount is debitable to the **Major Head 3. (iii)** (code-35 and 31) and is valid for payment during the financial year **2012-2013 only**.
- 2. The Grant is subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proxima submitted by the University / Colleges/ Institution.
- 3. The College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the Grants which shall be utilized only on approved items of expenditure.
- 4. The utilization certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission as early as possible after the close of the current financial year.
- 5. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of University Grants Commission's Grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purposes other than those for which the Grant was given, without proper sanction of the University Grants Commission and should, at any time the College ceased to function, such assets shall revert to the University Grants Commission.
- 6. A Register of Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Grant shall be maintained by the University / College in the prescribed form.
- 7. The grantee institution shall ensure the utilization of grants-in-aid for which it is being sanctioned / paid. In case non-utilization/part utilization, the simple interest @ 10% per annum as amended from time to time on unutilized amount from the date of drawl to the date of refund as per provisions contained in General Financial Rules; of Govt. of India will be charged.
- 8. The College shall follow strictly all the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time with regard to reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- 9. The College shall fully implement to official Language Policy of Union Govt. and comply with the Official Language Act, 1963 and Official Languages (Use for Official purposes of the Union) Rules, 1978 etc.
- 10. The sanction issues in exercise of the delegation of powers vide Commission office Order N_{fc} 25/92 dated May 01,1992.
- 11. The funds to the extent are available under the Scheme.
- 12. An amount of Rs.25,00,000/- out of the grant of Rs.25,00,000/- sanctioned vide letter No.F.16-32/2004/2010 (NS/PE) 22.12.2010 has been utilized by the College for the purpose for which it was sanctioned and noted in Grants-in-aid Register at page No.22 & SI. No.16.
- 13. This issues with the approval of Chairman, UGC.
- 14. The terms and conditions of the grant will be as applicable during XI Plan for the Colleges.
- 15. "The University/ Institution/ Colleges is requested to strictly follow the UGC Regulations on Curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009".

Also, the Scheme may be implemented as per the Action Plan and in accordance with the provisions laid down in the guidelines for XII Plan which are available on UGC website (www.ugc.ac.in).

As informed during the interaction, the CPE funds should not be used on un-aided/self-financing department(s)/course(s) of your College. A certificate to the effect that the above instruction will be complied with may kindly be sent immediately. It was also observed during the interface meetings that certain colleges are still working as 'Composite College'. In such cases, the CPE funds should be used only for the degree/P.G. programmes and not for the "+2" programme. A certificate to this effect may also be sent to this office that provisions laid down in the guidelines will be strictly followed.

Further, balance 10% grant of the current phase is being released to your college separately subject to the receipt of the statement of expenditure and audited utilization certificate against the grant already released. You are requested to submit the same to UGC at the earliest, if you have not already submitted it.
