THE DEPARTMENT

The Department offers English as compulsory language, as Second Language and as one of the three major optional subjects at U G level and English Language and literature at P G level. The Department is a recognized research center of English affiliated to SRTMU, Nanded. The faculty is active in research activities; the department produced 23 M.Phil. scholars (Distance mode of YCMOU, Nasik). Twenty students are being guided by the faculty for their Ph.D. Programme and produced 15 Ph. D. scholars till date. The department has its alumni qualified for NET/ SET across the years. The faculty offers exclusive research in Indian writing in English (IWE), English Language Teaching (ELT), Linguistics, Critical Theory, British Literature, Common Wealth Studies and American Literature. Presently, twenty Ph. D. Research scholars are working in the Department. The faculty has completed two Minor Research Projects (UGC, WR, Pune) and one Major Research Project (UGC, New Delhi). The department published more than a hundred papers at various National and International journals and periodicals and penned books that are prescribed by the parent University at UG and PG levels. The head of the English Department, Dr. Ajay R. Tengse is the BoS Chairman of English and Dean of Languages in the parent University during 2012-18.Dr. Ajay R. Tengse is the elected BoS member of the parent University currently (2018-23).

The faculty actively follow ICT based teaching for making the teaching-learning activities highly student oriented and learner centric. In addition to the classical lecture method, the faculty members use modern use modern teaching methods like Seminars, discussion, presentation and tutorials to ensure an interactive participation of the student. The regular use of film shows audio/visual cassettes and CD'S enriching of their own knowledge and to make teaching more practical and student centric. The fully computerized language lab with twenty student's capacity established on the campus in 2008 is used by PG and UG Student for improving their English Communication Skills.





Apart from this the regular teaching in the classroom the use of language lab the teachers are very actively involved to counsel students towards varies issues like NET/SLET preparation, orientation towards TOFEL,IELTS and other proficiency exams, foreign offering foreign languages like French, Spanish and Spanish and Japanese languages and communicative English as career oriented courses is a special feature of department.

The Departments offers consultancy to schools and colleges in and around this region in the area of communication skills, personality development, Leadership, motivation, GDPI and other Soft skills. The department runs the activity Thought of the Day being written on the notice board of department every day. The department organized the Literary Film shows to the UG and PG students of English to develop interest among student.
