
Feedback Report from Parents 2021-22

43.8% parents strongly agree and feel that getting admission in YMN is a matter of pride for them.




34.1% of the parents strongly agree and 51.2% agree regarding the **fairness in admissions**.

College Discipline: 49% of the parents strongly agree for college Discipline, 43.1% agree.




39.4% parents strongly agree and 48.5% agree for atmosphere in the college being conductive for learning of their wards.

36.8% parents strongly agree and 51.8% agree regarding accessibility of college information to all.


39.3% parents strongly agree and 47.8% agree about the college website and its regular updation.
