Report submitted by Feedback Committee (2021-22)

Understanding Students' aspirations, views and suggestions in the form of Feedback is basically about the institutional practices, processes and frameworks that take into account the students' concerns of the quality of the education they receive. This practice assumes that there is an important relationship between the student's environment and learning, and that evaluation of that total learning environment is a necessary exercise. It normally includes following:

- Survey of the learning environment through questionnaires
- Student identity is kept confidential.
- Findings from Feedbacks have to be acted on by the management.
- Students have to be informed of action that has resulted in the expression of their views.
- Publication of student feedback and results i.e. encouraging transparency and openness.
- Reporting in accessible ways so that students find it understandable.

Through the Feedback activity, student participation may include helping them to understand their role in quality assurance of the college; to participate actively in the development and maintenance of quality provision of higher education and to be active players in creating an environment conducive to innovations and initiatives for an enriched campus life and development of Quality Culture within the institution.

In order to promote student participation in assuring and promoting the Quality, following different Feedback were collected.

- Student feedback on teaching-learning-evaluation and other related activities.
- Students Satisfaction Survey
- Parents Feedback
- Alumni Feedback
- Mechanism for follow-up action on all these feedbacks.

Students' Feedback Report – 2021-22

The institute feels that, students can become more responsible and sincere and develop a sense of belonging to the organization if they are given a chance to directly participate in the process. It also feels that students' response would help the institute in general and the teaching faculty in particular in understanding their aspirations, requirements, keeping the academic programs, the courses and course contents up to the mark and also fulfilling their learning-teaching demands. Therefore it has been using a Feedback system to collect the students' aspirations, constructive reactions /suggestions on courses, course contents and handling of the courses as well as infrastructure facilities available for them. This was done through academic year end online feedback collected through Google Forms.

Total 1267 students have submitted their responses regarding course of study, teaching-learning- evaluation system, infrastructure facilities available. 89.4% Undergraduate and 11.6% Post Graduate students have responded of which 15% BA, 30.3% BSc and 44.1% are BCom students.


About the Course of their Studies: While rating the course, in terms of skills, concepts & knowledge, **56.7%** of the students have rated the course of their study as **Extremely Good**, while 24.1% respondents rated it as Good.




About the applicability, relevance of the course to real life situations, 46.2% of students grade the course as **Extremely Good** and 30.4% as very Good. 49.7% admire the depth of course content too. Relevance or the learning value of Project Report is also expressed as **Extremely Good by 53% respondents**.

About the syllabus: 53.9% consider it as highly relevant, responding for benefits from the course, 48.1% consider highly relevant, 28.6% consider it as relevant while just 3.1% of the respondents submit that it was completely irrelevant.

About overall rating of Course of their studies, 54.6% give it the Extremely Good rating, and 27.9% rate it as Good.



About completion of syllabus, 55.1% agree that 90-100% syllabus was finished. 31.8% say that, 75-89% syllabus was finished.




53.9% agree that syllabus was highly relevant. 48.1% strongly agree for benefitting from the course of their study. 44.3% respondent accept as excellent for library holding of the course, 28.9% consider as adequate. 42.7% agree as **Very Good** for they got prescribed readings. 32.7% rate as good for the same.

For the internal evaluation system 46.6% say it as **Very Good**, 31.3% as Good. Total 44.5% opine that, Internal Assessment Should have 100% weightage for the total course, while 36.9% favour its weightage should be 75% & 11.8% say its weightage should be 50%.


Regarding the Internal Assessment 46.6% agree that, it help highly for understanding the course. 34.1% appreciably favours the same & 13.4% moderately favour it. While responding how the internal assessment help in early finding of difficulties, 31.6% respondents highly agree with it, 33% appreciably favours and 25.4% moderately agree for it. Whether Internal Assessment help to interact with the teacher, 47% favour it highly. 31.6% appreciate & 14.5% moderately agree for it.

How the Internal Assessment develope the habit of regular work & study, 53.8% highly grade it. 27.8% appreciate for it. 51.1% of the respondents highly favour that the Internal Assessment helps for Continuous Self Assessment. 30.4% appreciate & 12.4% moderately favour for it.

Program of Study: 56.3% respondents consider their programe of study at YMN is superior as compared to their peer learners at other colleges. 38.9% consider it similar with other college.



Regarding student Teacher relationship in general & at departmental level, 56.2% say that, it is very good, 27.1% consider it as Good. Just 11.3% consider it as satisfactory.




51.7% respondents find college administrative staff as Very Helpful, 28.4% as helpful.


For Hostel Facilities, 40.1% say it as Very Good. 26.4% say it as Good, 19.7% express as satisfactory.

For health care facilities, 40.9% say as Very Good, 29.9% Good, 17.6% as Satisfactory.






69.4% respondents consider the time spent at college is helpful in intellectual enrichment.



43.8% parents strongly agree and feel that getting admission in YMN is a matter of pride for them.




34.1% of the parents strongly agree and 51.2% agree regarding the **fairness in admissions**.

College Discipline: 49% of the parents strongly agree for college Discipline, 43.1% agree.




39.4% parents strongly agree and 48.5% agree for atmosphere in the college being conductive for learning of their wards.



- Parking should be provided free at the campus.


Feedback Report from Alumni 2021-22


More than 28% respondents are associated with Teaching Profession. Few are in private companies and business; some are in state and central Govt. Services.

40.7% rate Alumni Associatio n as excellent and 37% as very good.




51.9% respondents express excellent grade 33.3% Very Good, while responding for **Infrastructure and lab Facilities**.

66.7% excellent for availability of faculty. Regarding the Fee structure, 48.1% respondents express it as excellent.


Regarding the Hostel Facilities available for girls, 29.6% grade as excellent.

- 48.1% gave excellent grade while 40.7% gave very good for **skill orientation**.



100% respondents feel proud to be Alumni of this college.




88.9% respondents are Alumni members and they desire to be involved in Alumni Association activities.


81.5% respondents' grievances have been properly handled by the college.




The feedback for faculty members was collected covering the following skills/knowledge criteria.

68.5% strongly Agree and 19.1% agree that Teacher discuss topics and interact in the class.






