The total number of approved NCC cadets today is 13 lacs NCC is prevailing in 84102 schools and 5251 colleges in all the districts of our country. 11 group head quarter, 658 army wings units, 58 naval wings unit and 58 squadrons are working there in the country for imparting training to these cadets. Following are the Aims of NCC.
