Village Survey and Households Survey of The Adopted Villages

Data Feeding of The Survey

After the collection of data through the village survey and households survey forms provided by UBA. The online feeding of the same data has been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal during the period from October 2020 to December 2020.

1) Waghi Village:

Village survey and 150 household's surveys of Waghi Village has been undertaken and the same data is collected. After the collection of data, the online feeding of village survey and out of 150, 143 complete household's surveys have been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal.

2) Pimpalgaon (Korka) Village:

Village survey and 120 household's surveys of Pimpalgaon (Korka) Village has been undertaken the same data is collected. After the collection of data, the online feeding of village survey and out of 120, 103 complete household's surveys have been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal.

3) Naleshwar Village:

Village survey and 350 household's surveys of Naleshwar Village has been undertaken and the same data is collected. After the collection of data, the online feeding of village survey and out of 350, 343 complete household's surveys have been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal.

4) Rahati Village:

Village survey and 250 household's surveys of Rahati Village has been undertaken and the same data is collected. After the collection of data, the online feeding of village survey and out of 250, 210 complete household's surveys have been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal.

5) Kottirth Village:

After the collection of data, the online feeding of village survey and out of 120, 100 complete household's surveys have been done by our college faculties and students on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Portal.
